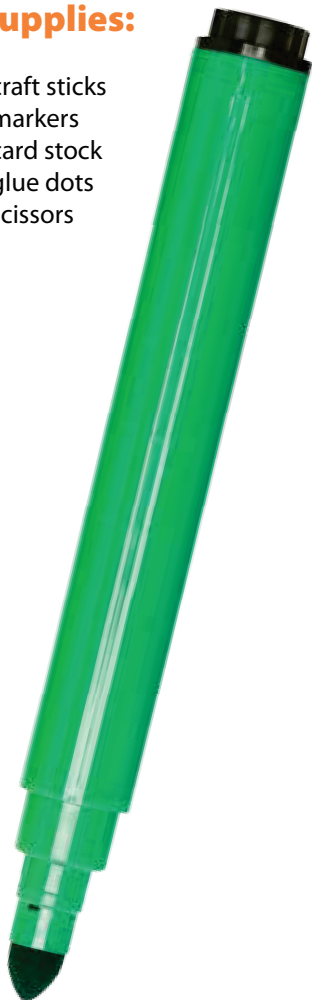
Who are Children in Action? WE ARE!

Project:

Help children learn the basics of Children in Action as they create and play "BOOM!"

Supplies:

- craft sticks
- markers
- card stock
- glue dots
- scissors



Instructions:

Before your experience:

1. Place supplies at each workspace.
2. Create a sample to show children.

During your event:

1. Instruct children to cut card stock into 2-inch squares.
2. Write elements of CA on each card and attach one card to each craft stick with a glue dot. Examples: *Send Me!*, *Philippians 4:13*, *I can do*, *CA Pledge*, *CA Motto*, *CA Scripture Verse*. (Create a variety of cards to review the basics of CA.)
3. Create several "BOOM!" cards on craft sticks. Simply write the word *BOOM!* on your card stock squares.
4. Instruct children to take turns drawing a craft stick from the container.
5. If a child can tell you something about the topic, he or she may keep the stick. If the child cannot, he or she must return the stick to the container.
6. When a child draws a "BOOM!" stick, he or she must return all of the sticks in his or her stack to the container.

Tip: Increase the complexity of the response required to keep the stick based on the age of the child. Having more cards and requiring a variety of responses will make the review game more fun. Children can create their own set of sticks or create sticks as part of a set for the CA meeting space.
