The Mission of CWJC/CMJC

Christian Women's Job Corps (CWJC) and Christian Men's Job Corps (CMJC) seek to equip women and men, in a Christian context, for life and employment. Through this ministry, each year thousands of women and men gain self-confidence, purpose, direction and hope for their future.

There are nearly 200 CWJC/CMJC sites in the United States and throughout the world. Each ministry site reaches men and women in ways specific to the needs of its community.

Pure Water, Pure Love



The Mission of PWPL

For many people, the uncertainty of clean water is a daily concern. Throughout the world, people are at constant risk of contracting a disease or parasite. This is why Pure Water, Pure Love (PWPL) exists.

The mission of PWPL is threefold:

- To supply missionaries with water filters.
- To provide the people missionaries serve with wells that offer clean water.
- To supply missions teams with water filters for use on short-term mission trips.

The Impact of PWPL

“Thank you so much for blessing our family with water filters through PWPL. Knowing that we will be able to have safe drinking water for our family, especially our little girls, takes such a load off of us.” — PWPL filter recipient

“I have been so excited to see how they have not just drilled wells but have continued to improve them, adding pumps, towers and even solar to one of them. The wells have also helped the ministry’s orphanage. Previously, children would haul their water down a dirt path or draw it from the dirty canal for bathing or laundry. Now it is piped in and they have immediate access. And the newly installed solar panel over the pump makes water available even when the electricity is out, which is often.” — PWPL grant recipient, Haiti

How You Can Get Involved

Join a community of women by taking a collaborative online leadership course: CWLC Leadership Certificate Program consists of nine four-week courses in the areas of Leadership Foundations, Leadership Formation, and Leadership Skills. Each \$30 course contains the course textbook in PDF format and provides holistic interactive assignments. Participants invest three to five hours each week to complete activities with a group of participants who watch short instructional videos, converse on lively forums, and complete online reflections, quizzes, discussions, and reading assignments. Participants will take three four-week classes each semester, one from each area of study.

Participants may take each course as a stand-alone course or as a part of the Leadership Certificate Program.
