## Chilean "Rock, Paper, Scissors"

1. Say: *Children in Chile like to play "rock, paper, scissors." In Chile, this game is called cachipún [kah-chee-POON]. The motions are the same, but as you hit your fist against your other hand, you must say one syllable of cachipún with each hit.*
2. Say: *We are going to add a little twist to the game. Find a partner and stand back to back. When I say go, you will hit your fist against your hand three times while saying cachipún. As soon as you say the last syllable, turn around and show your partner either "rock," "paper," or "scissors." Use a closed fist to show "rock." Show a flat, opened hand to show "paper." Hold out two fingers in a scissor shape to show "scissors." "Rock" beats "scissors," "paper" beats "rock," and "scissors" beats "paper." If you both show the same motion, you will both be out. If you lose the round, sit on the floor. If you win the round, walk around and find a new partner who is still standing. Continue playing until only one of you is left standing.*

## Would You Rather?

1. Tell CAs you are going to ask them a series of "would you rather" questions. If they choose the first option in each question, they must move to the left side of the meeting space. If they choose the second option, they must move to the right side of the meeting space.
2. Ask the following questions. If time allows, create some of your own questions that might fit your group. Or, challenge CAs to come up with their own list of "would you rather" questions.

*Would you rather:*

- *host a missions team in your country or go on a missions trip to another country?*
- *start a new church or attend a church that has existed for many years?*
- *work on a team or work alone?*
- *tell a Bible story to a group or teach a song to a group?*
- *ride the subway or ride a bus?*
- *live in America or live on the missions field?*
- *work inside in an office like Cinthy Case or work outside with volunteers like Cliff Case?*
- *play soccer at a sports camp or teach English at an elementary school?*
- *live in a big city or live in a rural town?*
- *learn a new language or taste new and unusual foods?*
