NOTES FROM YOUR CHILD'S LEADERS:

Bible Focus

Find Joshua 2 and 6 in your Bible and read together how Rahab showed kindness to the Israelite spies and how Joshua showed kindness to Rahab and her family. Write the name of each family member on a slip of paper, and let each person in your family draw a name. Make a commitment together that you will show kindness this week to the person whose name you drew – be creative!

Ministry Focus

Carlos and Lily Llambés realized there were preschoolers in their community in need, so they started a preschool at a church they had planted. Have a family game night with a twist – play only preschool board games! While having fun, pray together for the preschool leaders in your church and the families they serve.

Missions Focus

▶▶▶ Ice Pop Pass

As a family, invite some church friends to come for a day out in the park. Take a cooler filled with ice pops to share with people at the park and invite them to visit your church. Tell them *God loves me and He loves you, too--that's why He sent Jesus!*

▶▶▶ Supply Kit

Go together as a family to purchase supplies to donate to your church's preschool ministry. Purchase items like crayons, construction paper, and watercolors. Make an appointment to deliver the items to your church's preschool director and ask them to share how your family can pray for the preschool ministry.

▶▶▶ Preschool Play Date

Show kindness by inviting a family with preschoolers to come over to your home for a play day. As a family, plan snacks, games, and a craft you can do together. If they do not attend your church, invite them to visit with you.

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
