- 2. How could you be more openhanded this week with the life God has entrusted you with?
- 3. What is one new way you can begin serving this week, small or big?

- 1. When the Lord calls you to do something, how do you respond? Consider times you have obeyed immediately and times you have dragged your feet. What made the difference?
- 2. What does being a disciple of Christ mean to you? What should the life of a disciple look like?
