

Preschool Schedule Board

Supplies: “Preschool Schedule Board,” card stock, poster board, scissors, double stick tape, clear self-adhesive plastic, self-adhesive hook-and-loop dots

1. Print “Preschool Schedule Board” on card stock. Cut out activity cards. Note: On your printer, choose to print in color or black and white (sometimes called grayscale).
2. Work on a flat surface to assemble the schedule board. Use double stick tape to attach the “Welcome to Mission Friends!” card to the top of the poster board. Cover poster board and activity cards with clear self-adhesive plastic.
3. Arrange the activity cards from top to bottom beneath the welcome card, putting them in order of how you schedule your Mission Friends sessions. Add two loop dots to the back of each card and two hook dots to the poster board where you want to place each card.
4. Now you are ready to use your Preschool Schedule Board! Before preschoolers arrive, add the activity cards for the activities you have planned for the session. As preschoolers enter, and throughout the session, refer to the schedule board, pointing to each activity as it occurs. Soon, your preschoolers will self-refer themselves to check the schedule and see what happens next!
