



March Bulletin Board Idea

Supplies: light blue and tan butcher paper; scissors; stapler; precut alphabet letters; construction paper; tissue paper; markers

Directions:

1. Cover a bulletin board with light blue butcher paper. Add tan butcher paper along the bottom to create the ground.
2. Cut a simple outline of Shiprock (New Mexico landmark) from tan butcher paper. Staple Shiprock to the bulletin board so it stands out against the blue sky.
3. Along the bottom of the bulletin board, use precut letters to print:
Josh and Val Valdez started Higher Ground Church in New Mexico.
4. Use construction paper and tissue paper to make colorful hot-air balloons. On four different hot-air balloons, use markers to print:
 - Mr. Valdez preaches and teaches at Higher Ground Church.
 - Mr. and Mrs. Valdez love and help the people around them.
 - The Valdezes invite people to Higher Ground Church.
 - Mrs. Valdez teaches children and cooks meals for families.

Staple the hot-air balloons to the sky.

Tip: Invite preschoolers to make hot-air balloons to display on the bulletin board.
