During the month of October, Mission Friends will learn about Jack and Brennan Gibbs, special workers who help Ukrainian refugees get things they need such as food, water, clothes, shelter, and jobs. Help your preschooler pray for the Gibbs family.

Make a Prayer Book

Supplies: construction paper, stapler, old magazines, child-safe scissors, glue stick, markers

1. Help your child fold several pieces of construction paper in half and staple them along the fold to make a booklet.
2. Search together through magazines. Invite your child to cut out and glue pictures of ways to pray for others or to pray for the Gibbs family inside the prayer book.
3. Lead your child to draw pictures of family members on blank pages.
4. Add the Bible thought and a prayer request for the Gibbs family.
5. Use the prayer book to guide prayer during family devotions.

Open the Bible and read: Pray for one another (see James 5:16).
