



December Bulletin Board Idea

Supplies: red and green butcher paper; construction paper; scissors; stapler; tinsel garland; markers; small table; child-safe nativity set

Directions:

1. Cover a bulletin board with red butcher paper. Cut a large Christmas tree from green butcher paper and staple it to the bulletin board. Zig-zag garland across tree. Staple in place. Print **Telling Others About Jesus** across the top of the bulletin board.
2. Use construction paper to add a tree trunk and star. Cut large ornaments from construction paper. On three ornaments, print:
 - Brent and Amy Dorsett are special workers in Central Asia.
 - Pray for the Dorsett family.
 - Mr. and Mrs. Dorsett tell people about Jesus.

Staple ornaments on the tree.

Tip: Preschoolers can decorate blank ornaments with markers and glitter glue. Add to the tree.
3. Print the Bible thoughts on the bulletin board.

Jesus was born in Bethlehem (see Matt. 2:1).

Jesus loves you (see John 15:12).
4. Arrange the table next to the bulletin board. Place the nativity set on top for preschoolers to view.
