



# February Bulletin Board Idea

**Supplies:** blue butcher paper, stapler, scissors, markers, construction paper, magazines, glue sticks

**Directions:**

1. Cover a bulletin board with blue butcher paper. Draw a city street along the bottom of the bulletin board with markers.
2. Cut window shapes from yellow construction paper and glue them on construction paper to make apartments. Add details with markers. Staple in vertical stacks on the bulletin board to make apartment buildings lining the city street.  
**Tip:** Invite preschoolers to glue windows on construction paper and use markers to add doors and decorations on each apartment.
3. Use construction paper to make a scooter. Staple it on the city street. Cut people figures from magazines and glue them on the city streets as if they are walking along the streets.
4. Print the following on the bulletin board:  
**Catherine Knowles is a special worker in South Asia.  
Pray for Ms. Knowles on her birthday—February 9!**
