



May Bulletin Board Idea

Supplies: white butcher paper; scissors; markers; stapler; card stock; picture of the Wells family (see page 2); light blue construction paper; brightly colored yarn

Directions:

1. Cut white butcher paper to fit your bulletin board. Place the paper on the floor. Lead preschoolers to help you make vertical stripes with markers to cover the entire paper. Attach to the bulletin board to resemble a Peruvian fabric pattern.
2. Print a copy of the Wells family on card stock (see page 2). Attach it to the top middle of the bulletin board.
3. On pieces of light blue construction paper, print (one per paper):
Jim and Mandy Wells are missionaries in Lima, Peru.
Pray for Jim and Mandy Wells as they teach the Bible to children and adults in Peru.

Attach both papers below the Wells family picture. Cut a long piece of yarn. Fold it in half. Attach the fold to the bottom of the Wells family picture. Attach each end to the top of one of the blue construction paper sentences to connect them all together.

4. On a long strip of white butcher paper, print:
The Bible is useful for teaching us how to live (see 2 Tim. 3:16).

Attach the Bible thought to the bottom of the bulletin board.
