Pick and choose the questions that work best for your group. If discussion grows around one or two questions, feel free to focus on the topics sparking deeper conversation. ### Bible Study

1. When have you been blessed by the hospitality of a fellow believer? What impact did it have on you?
2. Who can your group welcome into community in a special way? How can your group display Christ's love to these people through hospitality?
3. How can you be bolstered to continue showing hospitality, even when your previous efforts go unnoticed or unrewarded or are rejected?

### Prayer

1. What aspects of your life do you use to “disqualify” yourself from acts of hospitality? In what ways could you overcome these aspects or adapt them in order to show biblical hospitality?
2. Hospitality is often associated with the home, but what are unique ways you could show hospitality in your group, your church, your workplace, or elsewhere?

### This Month's Spotlight

1. Opening your home for someone in need to stay may feel overwhelming and impractical—whether the need is short term or long term. What are your hesitations? What might help you be willing to open your home to someone in need? If opening your home is not an option, how could you support ministries in your community that meet similar needs?
2. Opportunities for missions are all around us—even missions among people from different countries. Do you live near immigrant or first-generation citizen communities? How could you get to know someone from one of these communities with the intention of sharing both your life and the gospel?
