

August Extra Activities

For Threes and Fours

Play a Piano

Supplies: church piano, pianist

In advance, get permission to visit a church piano. Ask a pianist to play "Jesus Loves Me."

Take preschoolers to visit a church piano. Sing along and watch as the pianist plays the song. Allow preschoolers to gently push the keys. Share that Mrs. Ku plays the piano at church.

Make a Box Train

Supplies: electronic tablet, cardboard boxes, construction paper, markers, scissors, tape

In advance, search online for train pictures.

Show the pictures. Let preschoolers make a train with cardboard boxes, markers, and construction paper. Say: Theodore Ku likes trains.

Dress Like a Sailor

Supplies: white pants, red and white striped shirts, blue and white striped shirts, red neck scarves, white children's sailor hats, digital camera

Guide preschoolers to dress up like a sailor using white pants, shirts, scarves, and hats. Group preschoolers and take their picture to share with parents. Say: Mr. Ku wants to start new churches for people who work at the seaport. His son, Theodore, likes the Navy and might join when he grows up.

Caution: Follow church guidelines when taking photos of preschoolers.

City Games

Supplies: sidewalk chalk, balls, preschool plastic baseball bat

Play games preschoolers might play in a city like hopscotch, catch, and baseball. Say: Churches are needed for families who live in cities in Orange County.

Caution: Supervise carefully. Play games outside or in a large open area.

Tell About Jesus

Supplies: [Allergy Alert Chart](#), play dough and play dough tools

Post the allergy alert chart. Invite preschoolers to build places people could hear about Jesus (coffee cart, church, home, etc.). Say: Jesus wants us to tell others about Him. Where could you go to hear about Jesus or tell someone about Him?

For Kindergarten

Moving the Coffee Cart

Supplies: [Pictures 9-10*](#); plastic connecting blocks

Discuss Pictures 9 and 10. Challenge kindergartners to use plastic connecting blocks to make a coffee cart, vehicle, and trailer to haul the coffee cart. Say: Karo Ku has a coffee cart he uses to help church leaders meet new people to invite to church.

Pray!

Supplies: play food, dollhouse, toy cars, people figures, whiteboard, dry erase pens and eraser

Show the food, dollhouse, cards, and people figures. Say: These are some things people pray about. Mr. and Mrs. Ku pray together when they have to make a choice about what to do.

Ask kindergartners to name things for which they can pray. Invite them to draw a picture of their prayer request. Take turns praying for the prayer requests. Conclude the prayer by praying for the Kus as they start new churches.

Beach Games

Supplies: [Allergy Alert Chart](#), plastic tub of play sand, beach toys, beach balls, beach towels, beach music

Post the allergy alert chart. Guide kindergartners to play in the sand with the beach toys, play catch with the beach balls, and play musical towels with the beach towels and music. Say: Mr. Ku wants to start new churches for people in Orange County who live near the beach.

Act Out Stories About Jesus

Supplies: smart phone, Bible storybook about Jesus, bathrobes, towels

Say: Churches are needed in Orange County for people who make movies. The people who make movies need to hear about Jesus.

Kindergartners can wear bathrobes and head towels to represent Bible times clothing. Read a Bible story about Jesus as kindergartners act it out. Record the Bible story retelling with the phone to share with parents.

Caution: Follow church guidelines about recording kindergartners.
