



September Bulletin Board Idea

Supplies: white, blue, yellow, black, green, and red butcher paper; hula hoop; scissors; stapler; markers; "Harris Family," see below; "Eiffel Tower," see below

Directions:

1. Cover a bulletin board with white butcher paper. Trace a hula hoop on the five colors of butcher paper to make the Olympic rings, making each ring slightly wider than the hula hoop. Cut out the rings and staple them on the bulletin board, overlapping them just like the Olympic rings.

Note: Alternatively, measure white butcher paper to fit the bulletin board. Use tempera paint to paint the Olympic rings on the white butcher paper before you attach it to the bulletin board. Dry before attaching to the bulletin board.

2. In the rings:

- In one ring, print: **Welcome to Paris, France!**
- In one ring, attach a copy of "Harris Family."
- In one ring, print: **Tell people about Jesus (see Matt. 28:19).**
- In one ring, print: **Pray for the Harrises as they tell people in Paris about Jesus.**
- In one ring, attach a copy of "Eiffel Tower."
