



November Bulletin Board Idea

Supplies: white, blue, green, and brown butcher paper; scissors; stapler; blue crepe paper streamers; construction paper; rope; markers

Directions:

1. Cover bulletin board with white butcher paper.
2. Cover the lower third of the bulletin board with blue butcher paper, gently tearing or cutting the upper edge to resemble the edge of a river. Staple one end of the blue streamer to one side of the bulletin board. Loosely twist the streamer and staple it in place on the opposite side to create flowing water. Repeat this until all of the blue butcher paper is covered.
3. Cut green and brown butcher paper to create towering jungle trees. Staple in place along the river's edge.
4. Use brown butcher paper and construction paper to make a floating house (see image below). Staple it on the river, attaching a rope from the floating house to the riverbank.
5. Use markers to print the following on the bulletin board:
Don and Maria Friesen are missionaries who live in a floating house on the Amazon River of Brazil.
