

## **December Bulletin Board Idea**

Supplies: white, blue, and green butcher paper; scissors; stapler; colored chalk; colored construction paper; markers; glitter pens; small table; child-safe Nativity set; instrumental Christmas music

## **Directions:**

- 1. Cut white and blue butcher paper to fit the bulletin board. Use colored chalk to create swirls of color across the paper to resemble the Northern Lights. Staple the butcher paper to the bulletin board.
- 2. Cut a large pine tree from green butcher paper. Staple it on the bulletin board. Add a yellow star to the treetop. On the bulletin board, use markers to print: Tell people about Jesus (see Matt. 28:19).
- 3. Cut a variety of ornaments from construction paper. Print a prayer request for the Doves on some, and the Bible thought on the others.

Pray for Zack and Jennifer Dove as they tell people in Scandinavia about Jesus. Jesus was born in Bethlehem (see Matt. 2:1).

- 4. Allow preschoolers to decorate the ornaments with glitter pens. Add them to the tree.
- 5. Set the table below the bulletin board with the Nativity set on top of the table. Quietly play instrumental Christmas music when preschoolers and their families are at church.
