

## **January Bulletin Board Idea**

Supplies: blue, white, and green butcher paper; scissors; stapler; colorful bulletin board trim; markers; construction paper; glue sticks

## **Directions:**

- 1. Cover the bulletin board with blue butcher paper. Add bulletin board trim around the edges.
- 2. Use green and white butcher paper to make snow-covered mountains on the bulletin board.
- 3. Cut three white clouds from butcher paper. On each cloud, use markers to print one of the following and then attach them to the bulletin board:

Families in Provo, Utah, enjoy ice cream! Pray for David and Sara Gaskins as they serve in Provo. God gives us things to enjoy (see 1 Tim. 6:17).

- 4. Help preschoolers trace around their hand and lower arm and cut out the shapes.
- 5. Provide construction paper so preschoolers can cut out triangle ice cream cones and ice cream scoop circles. Let them glue the scoops on top of the cones and then glue the cones on their hands. Attach the hands holding ice cream cones to the bulletin board.
