



March Bulletin Board Idea

Supplies: digital camera, blue and white butcher paper, scissors, stapler, bulletin board trim, construction paper, tape, copy of page two "Ferris Wheel Pod Template," markers

In advance, take and print photos of two preschooler "friends" standing beside each other, making sure all preschoolers are included in at least one photo. Print the photos.

Caution: Follow church guidelines for taking photos of preschoolers.

Directions:

- Cover the bulletin board with blue butcher paper. Fringe-cut strips of green construction paper into grass and attach it along the bottom of the bulletin board. Add bulletin board trim.
- Cut a large Ferris wheel and base from white butcher paper. Staple it to the bulletin board. Use different colors of construction paper to make 6-12 Ferris wheel pods (depending on how many preschoolers you have). See page two for a template. Staple pods around the Ferris wheel.
- Cut around preschooler "friends" photos and place one pair in each pod. If you have more photos than pods, place additional friends in a line along the ground as if they are waiting for a turn to ride the Ferris wheel. Or you can double up the "friends" who ride in each pod.
- Make a sign for the Ferris wheel on construction paper. Print the following on construction paper and attach it to the center of the wheel:
**La Grande Roue de Montréal
Montréal Ferris Wheel**
- On the bulletin board, use markers to print:
**Dylan and Autumn Pentecost make friends in
Montréal and tell them about Jesus.**
